- When asked to list medical conditions the identified clients are dealing with, respondents identified 166 different conditions. Examples of the medical conditions being dealt with by prevalence are:
  - 1. Hypertension 63
  - 2. Diabetes 57
  - 3. COPD 31
  - 4. Cancer 27
  - 5. Arthritis -26

- 6. Heart Disease 24
- 7. Substance Abuse 21
- 8. Dementia 18
- 9. Mobility Issues 18
- 10. Obesity 18
- When asked if "Is your agency equipped to assist these residents with their aging (Health) concerns"?
  - No 55 respondents
  - Yes 18 respondents
- When asked "What resources would help you be better able to serve them", respondents identified the following as the services most needed.
  - 1. Having Nursing/Medical staff within program 29
  - 2. Having on-site Health Aid -24
  - 3. Space that is ADA compliant/ Funding to adapt physical space. 18
  - 4. Increased funding for additional staff. 12
  - 5. Funding for transportation to medical appointments 11
  - 6. Access to alternative care when appropriate 9
  - 7. Funds for adaptive equipment 7
  - 8. Better pay for staff 6
  - 9. Additional staff training 6
  - 10. Increased communication with medical providers 5
